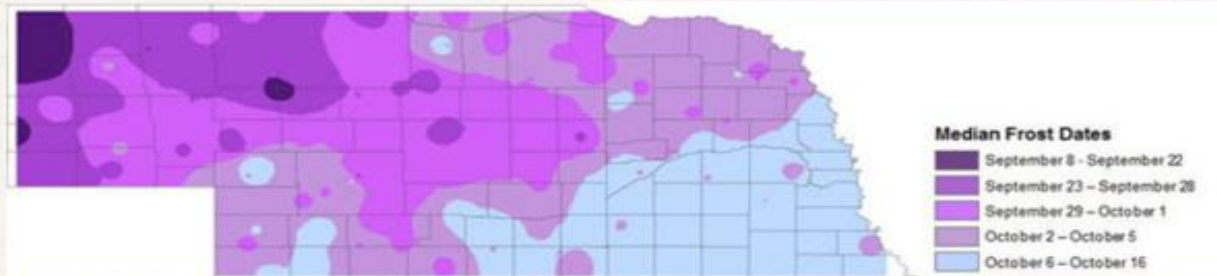

Vegetable Crop by Frost Tolerance

- Hardy vegetables – Broccoli, cabbage, kohlrabi, onions, lettuce, peas, radish, spinach, turnips
- Semi-hardy vegetables – Beets, carrots, cauliflower, parsley, parsnips, potatoes, and Swiss chard

Add 14 Days for Frost Tender Factor:

- Tender vegetables – Beans, celery, corn, cucumbers, New Zealand spinach, and summer squash
- Very tender vegetables – Lima beans, cantaloupe, eggplant, pepper, pumpkin, winter squash and pumpkin, tomato, and watermelon
